

Profile

The Institute of Fire and Safety Engineering, Nagpur is managed by Shri Arvind Singh Bahuuddeshiya Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur (Reg. No. F-22242). This has been working in the field of education, emergency aid, training, consultancy, equipment and maintenance. This is an autonomous institute managed by a group of well experienced fire personnel. It is situated about 18 Kms. away from the Nagpur Railway Station. The atmosphere of this institute is eco-friendly with ultra modern facilities and modern fire fighting equipment and training. This is the only institute in India which is running those kinds of course which can cater to the needs of the modern industry and fire department to produce right kind of trained fire and safety personnel.

Aim

Fire and Safety services in India at present are backward to a considerable extent. While few metropolitan cities are equipped with modern fire fighting machines and well trained personnel, in the innumerable other cities and towns, inefficient fire and safety personnel have been assigned with the responsibility of maintaining fire protection arrangements and fighting any possible outbreak of fire.

India is still in dearth of trained fire personnel. In this regard, Institute of Fire and Safety Engineering, Nagpur, has taken bold step to train the people and make them aware of fire and safety with modern fire fighting equipments so that they may cope with the modern requirement of the industry and fire department.

In case of fire and other disasters, trained personnel will be in a position to detect fire risks in the cities and at various industries and handle the emergency situations efficiently and smoothly.



Present Scenario

In western countries, well trained Fire -Safety personnel are available, although, they are very few in number. India has large manpower resources; it can be better exploited and utilized. In India, there is only one Fire College, which is only for the govt. employees and the yearly pass out number is less than 75 personnel. It is estimated that India will need 5 lac well trained fire and safety personnel every year. To cater to the demand of trained fire safety personnel, a good institution is required which can supply the personnel in fire as well as in safety field.

Institution of Fire and Safety Engineering has initiated the challenge by setting up training institution for fire and safety to cope with the needs of emergencies in India and abroad. It is estimated that only 0.2% of fire/safety trained personnel are available of demand in India.

Knowledge of Fire, Safety, Prevention, Protection, Fire Fighting Process, Environment and Disaster Preparedness are very important to prevent loss of life and property. Thus specialized training and role of the fire fighting agencies/departments are very important. Well trained manpower in this area is the need.

Disaster Awareness

At the time of Vulnerability or Disaster like Flood, Earthquake, Volcanic Eruption, Land Slides and Technological Disaster a Student will be able to organize and facilitate timely and effective Rescue, Relief and Rehabilitation operations, setting up disaster relief machinery, formulation of emergency relief plans, training of specific groups to undertake rescue and relief.

It is becoming increasingly evident now that relatively smaller disaster preparedness can save thousands of lives and vital economic assets as well as reduce the cost of overall relief assistance.

We have disaster management plan some of which have been carried out by govt., some by community based organization and some by institutions like us.


Safety Management








Fire Fighting Techniques



Besides the above there is also scope for the trainees in the fields such as Government Sectors, like Railways, Nuclear Plants, Heavy engineering, Semi. Government Sectors etc. Apart from this successful trained personnel can also work as an independent fire and safety consultant.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

We build personal rapport with every student to over come his problem in learning the art of Fire and Safety Techniques. We create such a situation that allows relatively relaxed discipline & a personal rapport of each student. We believe in positive approach to discipline. We see discipline as a means of helping student to learn acceptable behaviour according to the levels of development; we reserve the right tot initiate the procedure for dismissal of the candidate.

Those students, who feel that discipline is a punishment, need not take troubles to apply for admission at the Institute. Students should follow the following instruction:

- 1. It is imperative that the students strictly adhere to the day of opening and closing of each term during the academic year.
- 2. All students are responsible to the Principal for their conduct in the institute premises and in public.
- 3. Liquor consumption, smoking, chewing tobacco and other such elements are strictly prohibited in the Institute's premises.
- 4. Students should form a habit of looking in to the notices on the notice board on a daily basis without fail.
- 5. Students should take particular care to be punctual. Students who are late would not be allowed in the class.
- 6. Regularity is of utmost importance and thus absence at even a single lecture will be considered as absence for the day.
- 7. Students should have attended at least 80% of each theory and practical classes, failing this will debar from the examination.
- 8. The principal is competent to condone deficiency in attendance as per the rules.
- 9. All tests, theory and practical examinations are compulsory and every student has to appear for these examinations.
- 10. The candidate should have carried out the Project Work / Term Work prescribed for the course to the satisfaction of the Principal and head of the institution and should be certified as fit for appearing for the examination.
- 11. Proper clearance from respective department towards the progress,

- conduct, character, etc. will be essential for appearing in the examination.
- 12. In all cases of absence an application duly endorsed by the parents / local guardian must be submitted to the office of the institute immediately. If absence is on medical ground, certificate from the registered medical practitioner must be attached with application along with the fitness certificate. In doubtful cases, the student will be referred to the competent medical practitioner as per the choice of the Institute's and the report produced by the same will be treated as final.
- 13. Student will have to pay for the replacement or repair of the Institute's property loss or damage caused by them through carelessness or improper use.
- 14. The Institute's authorities cannot hold themselves responsible or liable for any loss of belongings of the students. However, any articles found in the institute premises should be handed over in the Institute's office so that steps can be initiated towards returning of the same to the rightful owner.
- 15. The institute office should be informed in writing of any change in address of the students with immediate effect.
- 16. Insubordination and rude language or misconduct is sufficient reasons for the suspension of the student. The student must remember that respect is the reciprocal of respect.
- 17. The student should not participate in any political or antisocial activities; otherwise the student will be liable to be expelled from the institute.
- 18. The student should help in maintaining the building and campus clean and tidy.
- 19. The management reserves to itself the right to make additions or alterations to the existing rules, working hours, time-table and mode of training as may be deemed necessary from time to time. The students shall be required to abide by the rules that are in vogue and that may be enforced in future from time to time.
- 20. Fees once paid are neither refundable nor transferable on any grounds. Institute reserves the right to increase or decrease all fees and charge, as well as add or delete times of expenses without advance notice as circumstance in the judgment of the administration may require.



STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- 1. Students enrolled at institute are expected to conduct themselves properly at all times. They are expected to observe standards of behavior and integrity that will reflect favorably upon themselves, their families and the institute.
- 2. They are expected to abide by the laws of the city, state and nation, and by all rules and regulations of the institute.
- 3. Accordingly, any student who demonstrates an un willingness to adjust to the rules and regulations that are prescribed or that may be prescribed to govern the student body will be placed or probation suspended or expelled from th institution.
- 4. Each student is subjected to official regulations governing student's activity and student behaviour. Further more, it is the responsibility of each student to adhere to the principles of academic integrity.
- 5. Academic intergrity means that a student is honest with him, fellow students, instructors, and the Institute in matters concerning his educational endeavours.
- 6. Thus a student should not falsely claim the work of another as one's own, or misrepresent him so that the measures of one's academic performance do not reflect his own work or personal knowledge.
- 7. If there are reasonable grounds to believe that a student has disregarded the regulations or student responsibilities, he may be disciplined. Such discipline may include suspension or expulsion.

Terms & Conditions



- 1. Though the admissions are made on Physical / Medical / Educational Qualification basis the management reserves its right to reject any application Immediately or later without assigning any reasons.
- 2. The fees will neither be refunded for any reason nor can it is transferred to any other person
- 3. Final Examination Hall Ticket will be given only after clearing all fees and dues.
- 4. The management reserves the right to rusticate any student for misbehaviour with staff or students.
- 5. No refund of fees will be made in any of the cases of rustication of the student by the management.
- 6. The original certificates submitted at the time of admission to the institute will not be given back upto the time of completion of course.
- 7. The management reserve the right to recover any damages caused to the equipment and property of the institute or the industry where the student is sent for training.

- 9. Degree / Diploma / Certificate will be issued only after satisfactory completion of all formalities required as per university rules and regulations.



TERMINATION GROUNDS

- 1. When his conduct is unsatisfactory.
- 2. When his ability to do his practical work proves unsatisfactory.
- 3. The academic representative will have power to terminate a student on grounds of misconduct, poor academic performance, etc.
- 4. When damage is caused to Institute property deliberately.
- 5. When payment of fees and dues are not made within the prescribed period.
- 6. When the student is found participating in agitation, political activities or acts prejudicial to the institute.
- 7. When his health conditions are unsatisfactory.
- 8. When suitable response is not forthcoming from his parent / guardian to communication issued by the institute or when parent / guardian withdraws in writing, the surety furnished for the student.
- 9. Students will be responsible individually or collectively (as the case may be) for any loss or damage to the property of the institute.
- 10. Any student indulging in Anti / Government / National or Anti-Institute propaganda will be expelled from the Institute Immediately and he will have no claim on fees paid by him.
- 11. If any information furnished in the application is found to be incorrect.
- 12. When his activities are found detrimental to the interest of the institute staff and other students.
- 13. If found addicted to alcohol or drugs or taking part in gambling or any other immoral acts.
- 14. When found engaged in unhealthy propaganda against Government, Institute and staff.
